Be aware of others.

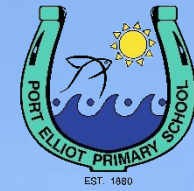
Walk together as a class to other learning spaces.

HOME TIME AT THE END OF THE DAY

Please walk and leave the school politely and respectfully. Say goodbye or 'see ya' to others, and leave safely and sensibly.

BUS DUTY

All students must stay in the play equipment/sand pit area if you are waiting to catch the bus home.

Leave your bag by the fence ready to collect when you catch the bus.

Collect your bag, have your bus pass ready and walk to the bus ready to line up when your teacher calls you.

It is the students' responsibility not to miss the bus.

All students without parents are to be sent to the office once the bus leaves.

The bus duty teacher will lock the back gate, bike shed and the back gates on the oval.

SCHOOL WALK

Always wait for a teacher at the gate before starting the school walk.

SANDPIT RULES
